FALL HOLIDAY INTRODUCTION AND THE POWER OF ELUL

YESHUA IN THE FALL HOLIDAYS

Session Summary

The Fall Holidays are filled with Biblical, Historical, and Prophetic significance. Yeshua celebrated these days. And His return is directly connected to the Fall Holidays. But we don't wait until the Fall Appointed Times arrive to prepare. Spiritual preparation begins one month before Rosh HaShanah, so we will be ready to meet with God when the shofar blows.

KEY TERMS

Rosh HaShanah/Feast of Trumpets/Yom

Teruah Is considered the "Jewish New Year."

Rosh HaShanah is also a day to blow the shofar in anticipation of Yeshua's return.

Yom Kippur Is the Day of Atonement. This day is widely considered the holiest day on the Biblical calendar.

Sukkot also known as "Feast of Tabernacles" or "Feast of Booths." This holiday celebrates God's provision during the Israelite's 40 years in the desert.

Tishri the 7th month on the Biblical calendar in which the Fall Holidays occur.

Elul the month preceding the Fall Holidays, which serves as a month of preparation.

Teshuvah the Hebrew word for "repentance." This word is connected to the idea of "returning."

Metanoia the Greek word for "repentance." This word means "to change one's mind."

Cheshbon Nefesh a Hebrew phrase that means "an accounting of the soul."
