Session Summary

Rosh HaShanah is one of four **new years** on the Biblical calendar. On Rosh HaShanah, we focus on God as Creator, King, and Judge. This appointed time is a critical moment to do a spiritual **annual review** to consider if we are maximizing what God has entrusted to us.

KEY TERMS

Rosh HaShanah

In Hebrew, means **head of the year**. It is the first day of the 7th month.

The month of Nisan

The new year for the Biblical holidays and calendar.

The month of Elul

The new year for the tithing of animals.

The month of Shevat

The new year for the tithing of trees.

The month of Tishri

The new year for the counting of years. It is also the birthday of creation in Jewish tradition.

Shofar

The ram's horn that is blown at Rosh HaShanah

Judgment Seat of Christ

A future judgment where God will evaluate the actions of His people.
