### YESHUA IN THE FALL HOLIDAYS

#### Session Summary

The central symbol of Rosh HaShanah is the shofar. It is a sound intended to wake us up to be on spiritual alert. The New Testament also associates the shofar with Yeshua's return. In this lesson, we will learn how the Jewish community celebrates Rosh HaShanah and how we can grow spiritually on this holiday.

#### KEY TERMS

**Yomim Noraim** – Hebrew for *Days of Awe* – the ten days between Rosh HaShanah and Yom Kippur. In Jewish tradition, it is time to ensure you are written in the Book of Life.

**Book of Life** – a symbolic book mentioned in the Bible, representing a list of the names of those judged favorably.

**Mussaf** – a set of prayers on the Sabbath and holidays to remember the additional Temple sacrifices offered during these times.

**Tekiah** – a single blast of the shofar; the sound of the heart cry of the Father for His children.

**Shevarim** – 3 connected, short shofar blasts representing the sound of a broken heart.

**Teruah** – 9 short blasts of the shofar representing a united, reconciled experience of the community.

**Tekiah Gedolah** – the final, long blast of the shofar representing wholeness and the return of the Messiah.
