SESSION 4 YOM KIPPUR - PART 1

YESHUA IN THE FALL HOLIDAYS

Session Summary

Yom Kippur is the holiest day on the Biblical calendar. It is a special day to repent of our sins and seek God for His mercy. Today, we will see how Yeshua's death connects to and builds upon Yom Kippur.

KEY TERMS

Kippur – The Hebrew word for **atonement**. This word means **to wipe**, as in **to wipe clean**.

Leviticus 16 – The chapter in the Torah which provides the most details on the procedures for Yom Kippur when the Tabernacle and Temples were standing.

The Priests – These men were appointed by God to offer the sacrifices on Yom Kippur.

Azazel/Scapegoat – A particular goat that symbolically carried the sins of Israel to the desert on the day of Yom Kippur.

Talmud Tractate Yoma – This section of the Talmud records the story of a famous crimson cord that stopped turning from red to white around the same time Yeshua died and rose.
