A HIGH DEFINITION LOOK AT GENESIS 4-11

Session Summary

This session explores the lives of Enoch and Noah, two men whose walk with God set them apart in a chaotic world. Rabbi Jason unpacks the difference between merely existing and truly walking with God—living with purpose, faith, and intimacy with the Creator. We will also reflect on leaving a lasting legacy and what it means to believe that God exists.

The Hebrew term for God's commandments.

Chesed

The Hebrew word for kindness.

Hanoch

The Hebrew word for *Enoch*, which means *dedication*.

Yirat HaShamayim

The Hebrew term for fear of the Lord.
